

Think in terms of protecting life and property during inclement weather.

Some Necessary Precautions Include:

- Employee Safety Comes First! Monitor radio and television advisories from the National Weather Service
- Stay inside -- even during the eye of the storm
- Ensure the availability of flashlights in the event of power loss
- Have a fire extinguisher ready in case of fire
- Store all perishable food in the Coolers and Freezers
- · Raise stored goods off the floors in the event of flooding

After the Storm

- Drinking water and food may be contaminated -- be careful!
- There may be problems with gas or electricity. Contact the utilities if you suspect a leak or other problem. Report any downed power lines or any broken gas or water mains to the appropriate authorities.
- Look for any structural damage. Evacuate the premises if necessary.
- Do not go near fallen or low-hanging wires. Do not touch anything that comes into contact with them.
